Welcome and introduction	 The learning objectives for the seminar are to: Describe the management of common orthopaedic and general surgery conditions Explain the role of the anaesthetist in surgery Explain the types of medications used in surgery and their role in anaesthesia. Describe medication management in the peri-operative period. Identify antimicrobial stewardship principles in the perioperative period. Describe the management of post-operative nausea and vomiting and venous thromboprophylaxis in the surgical patient. Describe the management of post-operative pain including the use of regional techniques, patient-controlled analgesia and the role and risks of opioids.

Describe the management of common orthopaedic conditions. Review the types of procedures commonly performed by orthopaedic surgeons. Medication management in the perioperative setting	 Describe a perioperative pharmacist approach to patients in the perioperative setting. Identify the groups of medicines requiring modification during the perioperative period. Describe the management of medicines requiring modification during the pre-operative period.

Antimicrobial Stewardship in the Perioperative Period	 Describe how antimicrobial stewardship principles are applied in the perioperative setting Explain the rationale for and appropriate use of antibiotic prophylaxis in the perioperative setting Summarise the roles of pharmacists in discharge planning to facilitate continuity of medication administration and adherence

Management of the surgical patient after surgery: Post-operative nausea and vomiting and venous thromboembolism prophylaxis	 Identify risk factors for post-operative nausea and vomiting (PONV) Describe the management of PONV Identify risk factors for VTE in the post-operative period Describe strategies to prevent VTE in the post-operative period
Pain management in the perioperative period	 Explain the mechanisms of acute post-operative pain Describe different strategies used to manage post-operative pain Describe the classes of medications used to manage post-operative pain Describe the appropriate use of opioids in the post-operative period
Case studies: post-operative pain Review of a patient post-operatively following a total knee replacement – reviewing PCA, converting to oral analgesia, calculating discharge requirements	Apply knowledge of post-operative pain management in the post-operative period to patient case studies
Regular medications in the post-operative period	 Review the importance of continuing regular medications during the perioperative period Describe the modification and reintroduction of medication in perioperative and post-operative periods Identify the importance of good communication to ensure patients continue appropriate regular medications post-operatively Describe positive communication techniques to utilise with patients about their medications in the post-operative period
