BRAND NAME	EVENITY
DRUG CLASS	Monoclonal antibody (humanised) for osteoporosis
AVAILABILITY	Prefilled syringe contains 105 mg/1.17 mL of romosozumab. The solution is clear to opalescent and colourless to light yellow. ¹
pH	5.2 ¹
PREPARATION	Allow the syringe to reach room temperature before use. ¹
STABILITY	Store at 2 to 8 °C. Protect from light. ¹ Stable for 30 days below 25 °C. Do not return to the fridge. ¹
ADMINISTRATION	
IM injection	Not recommended
SUBCUT injection	Inject into the abdomen, thigh or upper arm. The usual dose requires two injections. Rotate the site of injection. ¹ Suitable for self-administration after appropriate patient education. ²
IV injection	Not recommended
IV infusion	Not recommended
COMPATIBILITY	Do not mix with other medicines
INCOMPATIBILITY	No information
SPECIAL NOTES	All patients require calcium and vitamin D supplementation to reduce the risk of hypocalcaemia. ¹ May cause pain and redness at the injection site. ¹
