TERMS OF USE

Community Discussions are a form of social media. Posts are recorded and retained indefinitely and, despite being posted in a private setting, could become public.

Community Discussions posts should

- be respectful and collegiate
- declare conflicts of interest
- comply with

 - [SHPA Conflict of Interest Policy](#)
 - [SHPA Code of Ethics](#)
- not disparage fellow members, SHPA or other organisations
- not be used for commercial gain
- not be used to advertise jobs, positions advertised on the SHPA Jobs Board are allowed
- not breach confidentiality of patients, colleagues or employers
- not be used to sell/disperse surplus stock.

REPORTING POSTS

Members can report posts that contravene these guidelines. The SHPA Secretariat will be notified of reported posts and can take any required action.
